

FCCAA ACADEMIC REPORT FOR INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS SECTION 16

PURPOSE

***TO TRACK THE ACADEMIC SUCCESS, MATRICULATION AND 4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS OF
FCCAA MEMBER COLLEGES AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE FCCAA HANDBOOK.***

COLUMN 1

List the total number of 1st and 2nd year participants in your athletic program by sports. Participant is defined as any player listed on your eligibility report at the beginning or end of the season, signed to an NJCAA LOI who may or may not have been reported on the eligibility form, or any student-athlete who has the opportunity to participate in practices, team meetings, study halls, etc.

COLUMN 2

List the total number of 2nd year participants in your athletic program by sports. 2nd year is defined as playing in their second season of competition and does not include their academic status as a college student. Participant is defined as any player listed on your eligibility report at the beginning or end of the season, signed to an NJCAA LOI who may or may not have been reported on the eligibility form, or any student-athlete who has the opportunity to participate in practices, team meetings, study halls, etc...

COLUMN 3

Any 2nd year student-athlete who has successfully completed all graduation requirements at the end of the summer terms.

COLUMN 4

Any 2nd year participant who attends a four-year college whether on athletic aid or not and is confirmed by the athletics director.

COLUMN 5

Any 1st year participant who transfers to a four-year college whether on athletic aid or not and is confirmed by the athletics director.

COLUMN 6

All 1st and 2nd year participants who transfers to a four-year college and receives athletic aid.

COLUMN 7

All 1st and 2nd year participants who signed professional contracts.

COLUMN 8

All 1st or 2nd year participants who were selected to All-Conference Academic Teams.

COLUMN 9

All 1st and 2nd year participants who were selected to the FCCAA All-State Academic Team.

COLUMN 10

All 1st and 2nd year participants, who were selected to the NJCAA Academic All-American Team.

COLUMN 11

All 1st and 2nd year participants who were selected to the NJCAA Distinguished Academic All-American Team.

COLUMN 12

All 1st and 2nd year participants who were selected to Who's Who of American Colleges and Universities.

COLUMN 13

All 1st and 2nd year participants who were selected to OTHER ACADEMIC HONORS not listed in the previous columns. These honors MUST BE LISTED ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF PAPER AND SENT TO THE CONFERENCE CHAIRPERSON WITH THE SECTION 16 REPORT.

COLUMN 14

List the academic team at your institution with the highest GPA and include documentation as follows:

Number of college credit hours attempted for graduation (does not include college prep)

Number of quality points accumulated

GPA by dividing hours into quality points

COLUMN 15

Colleges-Submit each community service project on the official CAA Community Service Form

Conference Chairs-List the total community service projects by sport on the Section 16 Report and attach a copy listing the community service projects by name with the Section 16 Report.

CAA Chair- List the total community service projects by sport on the CAA Section 16 Report and attach a copy listing the community service projects by name with the CAA Section 16 Report.
